THREATS

The cost of food and energy rises in the region. The effects of the pandemic and the war in Ukraine have contributed to the increase in inflation. While the effect varies between countries, all are being affected. Important effects are seen in Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Peru and Venezuela. This threatens to increase poverty and food insecurity. More information here.





CHALLENGES

In Colombia, financial inclusion continues to be a challenge. Credicorp's latest Financial Inclusion Index, which measures inclusion in terms of access, use and perceived quality of the formal financial system, gives Colombia (and Latin America) an inclusion score of 38.3/100. OPORTUNITIES

The Standards and Trade Development Facility (STDF) offers grants (\$50,000) to prepare technically sound and sustainable projects, and (\$1,000,000) to develop projects that improve food safety. food and animal and plant health capacity to meet international sanitary and phytosanitary requirements.
