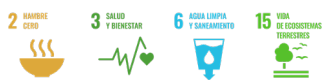
CHALLENGES

The electrification of transportation is a challenge in the region. Electric vehicles are in luxury segments and the number of public electric charging stations is limited (e.g., 2 in Bolivia, 3 in Ecuador). On the other hand, the contribution of renewable energy to electricity generation in Argentina, Bolivia, and Chile is less than 50%. More information [here](#)



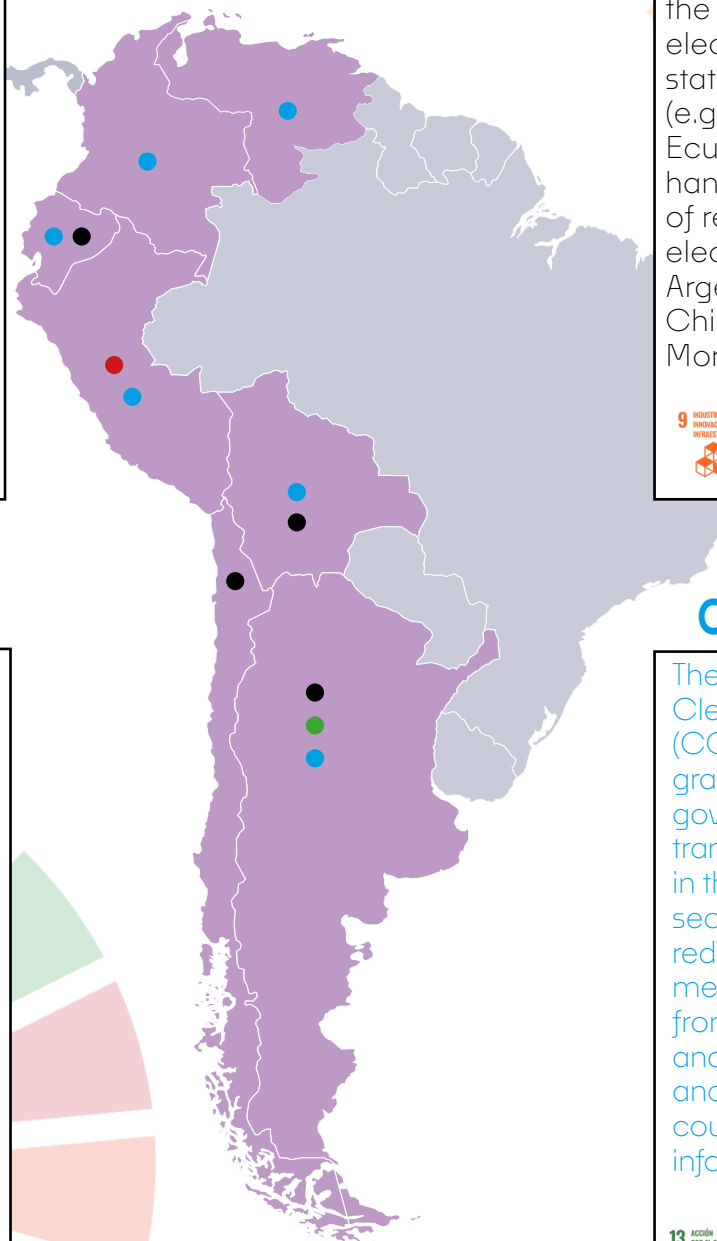
THREATS

In Peru, the government declares a state of emergency in areas of the Amazon due to the spill of approximately 2,500 barrels of oil.
