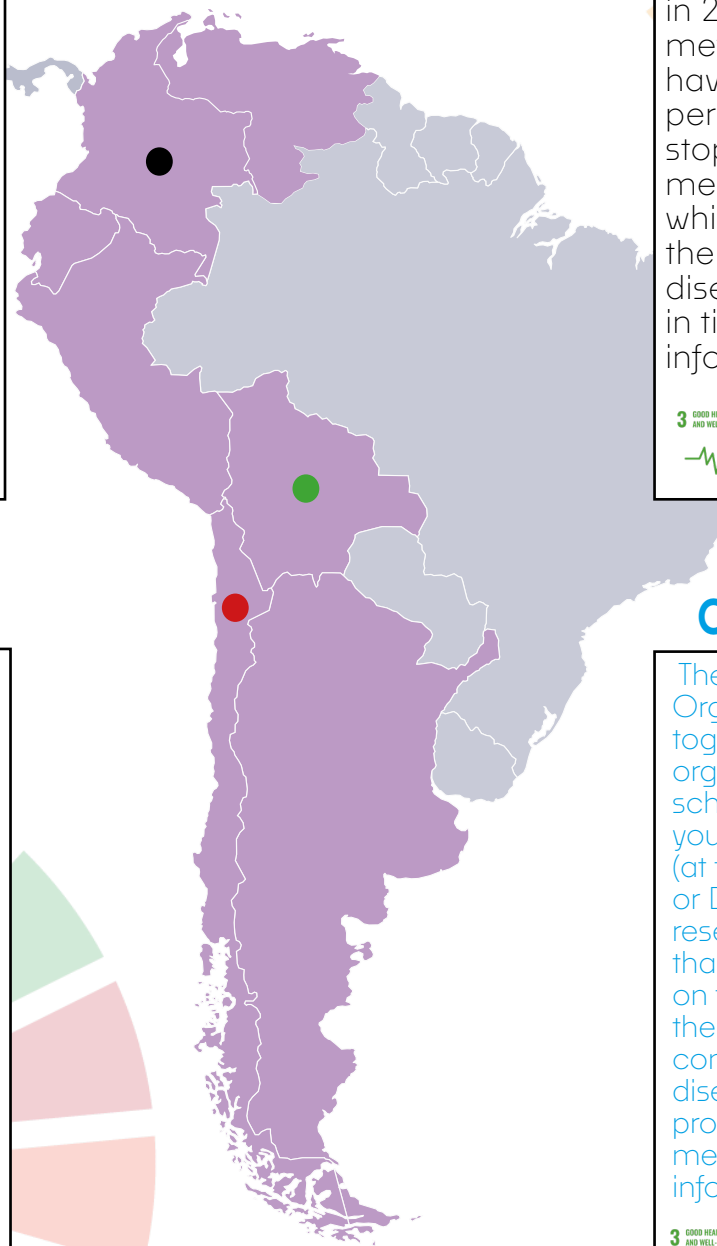
THREATS
