Even after the Glasgow Climate Pact (COP 26), and assuming compliance with all emissions reduction commitments made by all countries to date, global warming will not remain at 1.5°C or "well below" of 2°C (Paris Agreement). 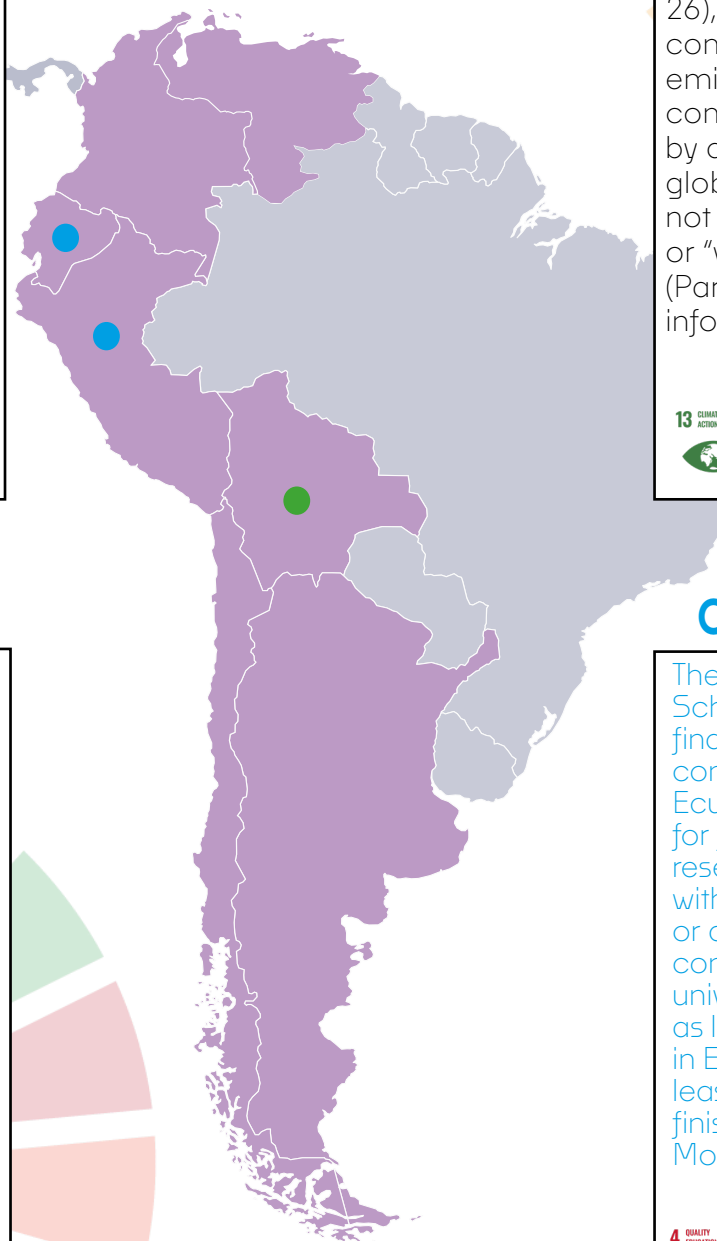
THREATS

The increase in global temperature has a profound impact on the Andean Glaciers. In recent years, the glacier mass has been receding annually by more than 70 centimeters.
